



Metzeler Racetec National Superstock Cup - Round 5 Snetterton

To the delight of his assembled fans, an ecstatic Johnny Angel on the Team Angel Racing Suzuki took his first victory in a perfectly executed finale.

Norman Brunton had earlier claimed his first pole position on the YZF-R1 Yamaha from Angel, CM Racing Kawasaki's Dean Johnson and Tom Clegg on the NCR Suzuki.

Track temperature had reduced for the last race of the weekend and Johnson was looking to maintain his 100% record over the past three rounds. As they got underway it was the young Angel who came to the fore, midway through the first lap. Lapping consistently, he was to maintain a steady cushion to win by four seconds and set fastest lap (1:09.013), from Brunton and Astro Kawasaki's Dijon Compton.

Dean Johnson's triple winning streak came to an end today with a damage limiting fifth place, his lead over Brands Hatch winner James Hurrell now reduced to four points. The riders head for Mondello Park for the next round in June.

Johnny Angel: *"My Metzeler tyres were great, I thought they might have gone off as I am using the K1 on the front and pushing hard but they hung in there until two or three laps from the end but I had a gap on the others by then – fantastic!"*
