Gernika, 4/5 June 2005 – The Grand Prix was very slickly run by the Gernika Off Road Club, with some truly superb special tests and at some points during the day, it seemed that most of the town had turned out to cheer on the WEC pilots, especially the local hero Ivan Cervantes/KTM/Metzeler.

While in Enduro 1 and Enduro 3 Cervantes and Knight both have eight 1st places in a row (100% win record), there are tough fights in Enduro 2. After recovering from his operation Merriman/Yamaha/Mi won both races, but still the Metzeler pilot Aro Samuli is leading the E2 overall standings.

The conditions during the first day were very demanding and due to the slippery conditions many riders lost precious time due to crashes.

The second day was held under perfect sunny conditions and allowed our high-class riders to fully exploit the performance of their bikes and tyres.

We are all looking forward to the 5th race at the Czech Republic, 2/3 July 2005, which will be half time of the championship
